What is Home Mission Sunday?

We all know someone who needs to hear the Good News that God loves and forgives them. Home Mission Sunday provides Catholic parishes, communities, families and individuals with the opportunity to reflect, pray and be resourced to share their faith with the many different people that they encounter every day.

This year's theme is 'They will know Him by the good works that you do' and has been chosen in prayerful response to the content of the Scripture readings for the day and the current economic climate. Parishes and individuals are being invited to consider how they can evangelise by showing their faith through loving support and service to those in need at this time. They are reminded to use the opportunities that present themselves to explain the reason for their actions as being found in Christ (1 Peter 3:15).

'It is the task of every parish and baptised person to break open for others the meaning of Jesus' story through witnessing to their faith through loving service. There is a powerful link between evangelisation and works of charity because, "Love of neighbour is a path that leads to the encounter with God, and that closing our eyes to our neighbour also blinds us to God". (Deus Caritas Est 16; 30b). Home Mission Sunday challenges us to take a fresh look at how we can show the face of God by the good works, small and large, that we do in daily life.

TO THE SHRINE OF ST JAMES

The parish church of St James, Weybridge, is planning a pilgrimage to Santiago de Compostela in May 2010, which is a Holy Year in Santiago. This is sure to be a memorable experience as we travel along the ancient Way of St James, culminating in an arrival at the great cathedral at Santiago, within which is the supposed tomb of the Apostle and to whom Weybridge's parish church is dedicated. However we also aim to make the journey equally interesting for those who appreciate splendid architecture and those who wish to absorb the culture and traditions of this historic pilgrimage route. We may even arrange a little wine tasting as we pass through the regions of the Rioja and the Ribeiro! Our route will be along what is known as the Camino de Santiago, 550 miles from the French border to the far north-western tip of Spain, over a period 9 days/8 nights, the last 2 days being in Santiago itself. Overland travel will be by modern air-conditioned coach and we will fly out from one of the London airports to Biarritz for the start and back from Santiago. We have planned accommodation in 3-star equivalent hotels, with one night at least in a monastery guesthouse. There will be an option to walk two short stretches of the pilgrim path to add to the experience. The Pilgrimage Director will be the Rev Brian Prothero, Rector of Weybridge. We welcome any members of the congregation of the Church of Christ the Prince of Peace who may be interested. This is being organised by Weybridge - for Weybridge. To receive fuller details of the itinerary, costs etc, please contact St James Church Parish Administrator on 856399 between 9.30 am -12.30 pm, Mon to Fri or call in at those times. No commitment is sought at this stage. To get a flavour of the pilgrimage, there is to be an audio-visual presentation on Tuesday 20th October in the St James Parish Centre (behind the church) at 7.30 pm. There is no charge for this and you may find we have laid on some Galician wine! You will be very welcome to attend.
